SB201 Hearing - Thank You!

More than 100 AGC Members, construction workers, and local elected officials were on hand last week to support [SB201](#) before the Senate Taxation Committee at the Nevada Legislature.

SB201 is enabling legislation to allow the Washoe County Commission to adopt an ordinance implementing the provisions of RTC Advisory Question 5 passed last November.

Due to the larger than expected crowd of over 60 people, attendees were moved to an "overflow room" to watch the proceedings on closed circuit television. The bill is expected to be acted upon at a work session of the Taxation Committee later this week.

According to legislative rules, committee action must be taken no later than Friday, April 10, so that the bill may be voted on by the full Senate and sent to the Assembly for consideration.
