Feds Begin ConsensusDocs Acceptance

Contractors working on water construction projects for the U.S. government now have the option of using two template construction-contract documents prepared by ConsensusDocs. The Agriculture Department's Rural Utility Service will allow contractors to use the Electronic Communications Protocol and the Contractor's Qualification Statement for Engineered Construction. Brian Perlberg, executive director of the ConsensusDOCS coalition, notes that the federal government is among several large-scale project owners to accept ConsensusDOCS documents.
