The U.S. Senate is drafting a comprehensive bill to address climate and energy, and is basing that work on a related bill passed by the U.S. House of Representatives. The third installment of AGC's summary of the American Clean Energy and Security Act of 2009 (H.R. 2454) highlights the major provisions of Title III (Reducing Global Warming Pollution).
