AGC of America Reports On E-Verify

Department of Homeland Security officials recently said the employment verification system program (E-Verify) is capable of handling a surge in queries. Federal contractors are now required to use the system. More than 1,400 companies have signed up to use the database since it became a requirement earlier this month. The total firms using it is almost 151,000. The system is expected to process 9 million queries in fiscal 2009, up from 6.6 million in fiscal 2008.
