

Nevada Chapter AGC 2010 Contractor Dues

REGULAR CONTRACTOR MEMBERSHIP - General Contractors and Specialty Contractors who have been engaged in construction for at least two years prior to applying for membership (or a firm whose executive officers have had at least two years experience prior to entering such firm or corporation) and who have established a reputation for Skill, Integrity and Responsibility. The dues schedule shown for Contractor members includes National AGC service dues.

Additional Dues:

Signatory Contractors: An additional net amount of two cents (2¢) per hour for all construction field employees paid by the hour.

Open Shop Contractors: An additional twelve cents (12¢) per hour for all field employees not covered by a collective bargaining agreement.

Hourly Dues Cap

Small Contractors (Under 3 Million per Year) There is a cap on hourly dues of \$1,000 per million for each of the first three million dollars of volume. (\$100 for each \$100,000).

Billing

All fees are billed in January of each calendar year. The amount is based on your dues volume for the previous year. *(2010 dues are based on 2009 volume of work).*

Non-Home Chapter Members are a regular member whose principal affiliation is with another chapter, but who maintains a permanent presence in the subject chapter.

National dues are collected through the home AGC chapter.

Your 2010 dues are based on your 2009 volume of work.
