Dave was diagnosed with cancer in his pitching arm resulting in the removal of half of his deltoid muscle. He was told, short of a miracle, he would never pitch again. Proving the doctors wrong, he came back in 1989 to pitch a 4-3 win for the San Francisco Giants, but sadly his comeback was short-lived as the cancer had returned, forcing him to make the difficult decision to retire from baseball in November of that year.
